David W. Laws is Associate Professor at the Department of Political Science at the University of Amsterdam, Netherlands and is also Program Director of the Masters Program in Conflict Resolution and Government and a founder of the Amsterdam Centre for Conflict Studies.

Dr. Laws is a former Research Scientist and Lecturer at the Department of Urban Studies and Planning of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology where he was also co-director of the Environmental Technology and Public Policy Program. He is a Senior Consultant at Susan Podziba & Associates.

Dr. Laws specializes in ethics, public policy, and alternative dispute resolution. His research focuses on institutional development in environmental regulation and democratic governance. His recent publications include: "Talking With The Future: Sustainability as Intergenerational Dialogue" (coauthored with Lawrence Susskind) in National Forum; and "Human Health and the Environment: Unanswered Questions, Unquestioned Answers" (with Ambuj Sagar) in Environmental Impact Assessment Review. He was the recipient of the Martin Environmental Fellowship and MIT's Goodwin Medal for teaching in 1995.
